Town Lectures & Concerts 2017

For the eighteenth year, Ipswich Arts Association hosts a series of lectures and concerts. The lectures reflect the history and cultural background of Ipswich and Suffolk through the eyes of Suffolk-based speakers. Concerts are given by local musicians, featuring different styles of music through the ages. The monthly events take place at Museum Street Methodist Church from 1.00pm to 1.50pm. 12 January: Lecture by Mark Beesley introducing eight Suffolk-based painters from the last century. John Nash (see the picture above) is one of the featured artists.

9 February: Concert given by vocal group **Musicology** which formed back in 1994 for a one-off event and are still singing in harmony today. **9 March**: Lecture by Bob Merrett. Learn about the 19thC Woodbridge Wits, including Edward FitzGerald

The Ipswich Corn Exchange has an organ which was installed from a redundant Paddington church when the venue was re-opened as a concert and conference centre in the 1970s. Over the years the organ has suffered from the ravages of dust, water ingress and is in need of loving care.
