100 Years On....

The performances of *Ipswich Remembers* in 2018 brought to an end a two-year community project for **Ipswich Choral** Society and their Music Director, Robin Walker. Marking the centenary of the end of the First World War, different groups came together to create a special event blending music, song, dance, poetry and photography. These included the **Ipswich Art Society, Ipswich & District** Photographic Society and the Suffolk Poetry Society. A new musical commission by Huw Morgan portrayed a snapshot of Ipswich life from 1914 to 1918, concluding with Eternal Light: A Requiem by Howard Goodall. Mary Davies provided the choreography for dancers drawn from community groups supported by DanceEast.
