The Trianon Enigma: Pictures of Friends Within is the title both of Emeritus Professor Chris Green's lpswich Town Lecture on 12 September and also of a new book whose publication is announced that day. Planned to coincide with the Diamond Jubilee both of Trianon and 60 years of Chris's conducting career, the lecture will feature episodes from the life of this adventurous music group which, in many ways, is linked to the economic and social life of Ipswich and the surrounding area starting with three youngsters and their friends making amateur cine films and then producing concerts. The 50 minute Ipswich Town Lecture will be followed by a book-signing prior to a reception hosted by the Mayor of Ipswich to welcome former members back to celebrate the Diamond Jubilee.
